“AU EdPEX Assessor Training”


On April 2-3, 2022 9.00 – 16.00 hrs. at Salle d' Expo, Hua Mak campus




1. The AU EdPEX Assessor training was useful for the performance improvement of the School/Value Contribution Unit. (Average = 4.80)




2. I gained knowledge and understanding on EdPEx category. (Average = 4.52)




3. I realized the importance of the EdPEx as criteria for performance excellence. (Average = 4.60)




4. The keynote speakers provided clear information of EdPEx category. (Average = 4.84)




5. I am satisfied with the knowledge and experiences shared by the speaker. (Average = 4.68)




6. The time allotted the training was sufficient. (Average = 4.04)




7. The training venue was proper. (Average = 4.12)




8. The staff were helpful with the training. (Average = 4.88)
